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# ILLiad Remote Authentication

- ILLiad can authenticate users via your institution's single sign on (SSO) server
- In addition to sending the username, your identity provider can also send other user attributes (name, email, phone, department, status) that can be used to complete the registration form
- If all required values are sent, the registration form can be skipped completely

# ILLiad Remote Authentication

- OCLC hosted servers have been using EZProxy to authenticate their users versus directly connecting to the identity provider
- With ILLiad 9.2, OCLC hosted servers can now use a built-in SAML module to authenticate users
- After updating to 9.2, you can contact OCLC support for them to set your server up with the SAML module for authentication

# ILLiad Remote Authentication

- If you are currently using EZProxy and switch to the SAML module, your URL for ILLiad will change. It will no longer have the EZProxy prefix, but will only be your ILLiad URL.
- All links to ILLiad will need to be updated, including OpenURL links.
- You will need to coordinate with your institution's identity provider to get a list of all the released attributes
